City Score Card: Criteria Areas

BASIC NEEDS

City's marginalized residents' basic needs - housing, transport, energy, food, water and sanitation - are met

ECONOMIC INCLUSION

Access to decent livelihoods, financing, technical skills training and business development opportunities

SOCIAL INCLUSION

City enhances active community engagement, strong social networks, and social integration cohesion

SECURITY & JUSTICE

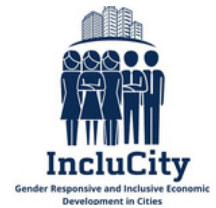
Systems of law enforcement, safe environment, fair justice, and prevention of crime and corruption

CONSULTATIVE INTEGRATED PLANNING & BUDGETING

Integrated plan and strategy development to address exclusion informed by data collection and monitoring

CITY LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT

Improved multi-stakeholder consultation, and effective, transparent leadership



CITY RANKING TOOL

Measures the effectiveness of the city policies, systems, plans and investments against inclusion criteria via qualitative and quantitative metrics.



ASSESS GAPS IN INCLUSIVE INVESTMENT

Assesses existing gaps and vulnerabilities within urban areas and assists municipalities devise appropriate inclusive investments for the most marginalized including women and girls, slum dwellers, ultra poor and minorities



PROMOTE LEADERSHIP AND ACCOUNTABILITY

Promotes accountability and strengthens local leadership to deliver on priorities and investments that specifically address the needs of the most vulnerable
